Campground Rules^[1]

- Fires must be contained in the fire rings provided. Never leave fire unattended and keep at a safe height. Fires should be extinguished before turning in as well as upon vacating site. Firewood is sold at the office/store.
- All vehicles must stop, register, and pay at the office before entering campsite. If nobody is available, please sign the clip board stating intent and name of person being visited.
- Pets must be on a leash no longer than 6'. (No dobermans, pit bulls, rottweilers, or chows)
- Quiet time is from 9:00PM to 9:00AM (Idling only).
- No visitors after 9:00PM or before 9:00AM.
- No firearms or fireworks.
- No cutting or removing trees or shrubs.
- No modifications to campsite without prior owner/manager approval.
- No more than 2 vehicles per campsite, and only if space is available.

Rider Code of Conduct^[2]

- Always ride within your limits, the limits of your machine, and the limits of the trail.
- Helmets are required. Full safety gear, including gloves, a long sleeve shirt or jersey, and boots are highly recommended.
- Keep your machine in top shape; tires, brakes, and cables should be inspected every time you ride.
- Consult your owner's manual and comply with the safety standards set forth by the manufacturer.
- Make sure that your machine complies with all local and state requirements.
- Only one rider per vehicle, unless the machine is specifically designed for two-up riding or has an approved seat. Consult your owner's manual for seat configurations.
- Ban the booze! No alcohol is permitted on the trails or in any riding area.
- Be courteous to other riders.
- be respectful to trail patrols and local law enforcement.
- Stay on the posted trails at all times.
- Ride single-file on the trails.
- Follow posted speeds.
- Do not be destructive to the land or animals that inhabit the land.
- Be respectful of creek crossings.
- Be especially respectful to the landowners who allow you to recreate on their property.

[1] These rules and regulations apply to you and all your guests. You are responsible for informing your guests of these rules. You are also responsible for their actions and their well being. Any violation of the rules deemed to be serious enough in nature by the campground's owners may be grounds for expulsion of all campers from the campground without refund.

[2] Our ability to provide the riding community with quality riding areas is directly dependent on our pass-holders' conduct. The above regulations assure that we make the TrailPass™ Network a success.
